3. Presenter agrees to make all appropriate	e arrangements with, and to obtain all copyright and other	

- clearances and rights from, broadcast stations, networks, sponsors, music licensing organizations, performers' representatives, program owners, program syndicators, and any and all other persons or entities as may be necessary to lawfully transmit the Program.
- 4. Presenter agrees that Operator assumes no risk and makes no guarantee, express or implied, regarding the safety of DVD's or other materials in Operator's possession. Presenter hereby releases and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Operator, its employees and agents from responsibility in the Program (and/or any related tapes or other materials) if damaged, lost or stolen while in Operator's custody.
- 6. Presenter acknowledges that Operator shall not be liable to me for failure of Operator to cablecast the Program as scheduled, whether because of the breakdown of equipment or any other reason. Presenter acknowledges that my only remedy upon Operator's failure is that the program may be cablecast at another time.
- 7. Presenter understands that Operator is relying upon this Agreement and the representations contained in this agreement in permitting the Program to be transmitted on the Access Channel.
- 8. Presenter understands that information regarding the submission or production of programming, including my name and address, may be made available to the public upon request.

- 9. Presenter agrees to grant OSM 16 the right to use segments from programs submitted for cablecast for promotional or other purposes unless specifically denied in writing.
- 10. Presenter agrees that, in addition to all remedies and indemnification's specified in this Agreement, the Operator may prohibit my further use of Access Channel should Presenter violate any term of this agreement.
- 11. Presenter understands that any tangible media submitted will not be retuned and will become the property of Open Stage Media.(so please no master copies please)
- 12. Presenter must have an accurate run time clearly labeled on the DVD or DVD sleeve or case. Run time will not include countdown or blank slates before or after show.
- 13. Presenter understands that by signing agreement the producer is allowing public access to email, phone number and address to whomever requests it.

## CONTENT RESTRICTIONS

Open Stage Media (OSM) is not to be considered a censor of any program material. OSM's only obligation is to insure that all Local, State and Federal laws are respected regarding programs shown on the access channels.

- 1. Presentation of the following material on OSM channels is prohibited:
- a. Advertising material designed to:
- 1) promote the sale of any product or service; 2) commercial programming which in whole or in part depicts, demonstrates or discusses products, services or businesses with the intent or substantial effect of benefiting or enhancing a profit-making enterprise; 3) any material which identifies any product, service, trademark or brand name in a manner that is not reasonably related to the non-commercial use of such a product, service, trademark or brand name on the program. Advertising material shall include, but not be limited to, references in the cablecast program, to (i) a monetary purchase price, (ii) a publication, (iii) a telephone number or (iv) a website, link, or E-mail address, which in any way promotes the advertising prohibited in the immediately preceding sentence. The use of a phone number, E-mail address or website is permitted as a reference at the end of the cablecast program but only on the condition that it be used to obtain additional information. Under no circumstances can it be used for advertising material.
- b. The direct solicitation or appeals for funds or other things of value for any and all purposes.
- c. Political endorsements or advertising by or on behalf of candidates for public office.
- d. Material which is defined as legally obscene.
- e. Any programming which constitutes or promotes any gambling enterprise in a manner which is in violation of any applicable local, state or federal laws.
- f. Material which constitutes libel, slander, invasion of privacy or publicity rights, unfair competition, violation of trademark or copyright, or which may violate any local, state or federal law.
- g. Material which has a reasonable probability of creating an immediate danger or damage to property or injury to persons, or of creating a public nuisance, or inciting a riot.
- h. Material or programming which has a reasonable probability of causing the substantial obstruction of law enforcement or other governmental functions or services.
- 2. When program content violations are brought to OSM's attention, OSM shall take such steps as are necessary to comply with FCC regulations and applicable City, State and Federal laws.
